The Chamber's 2025 funding is through five major areas:

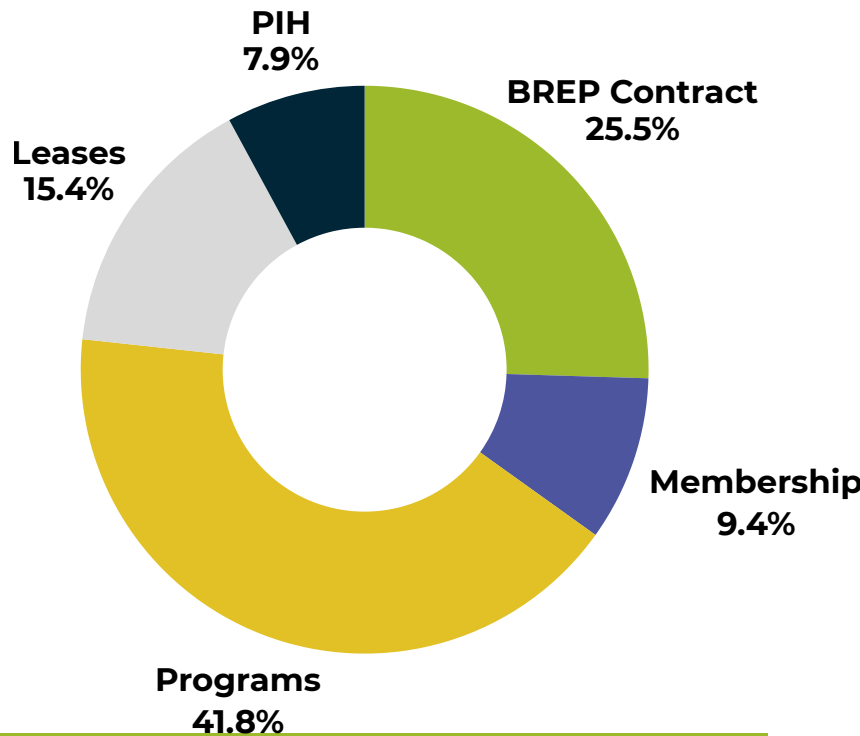
Programs - These are events with a fee to attend or sponsor.

The Chamber used data heavily in 2025. We use this as a way to evaluate overall satisfaction with the Chamber.

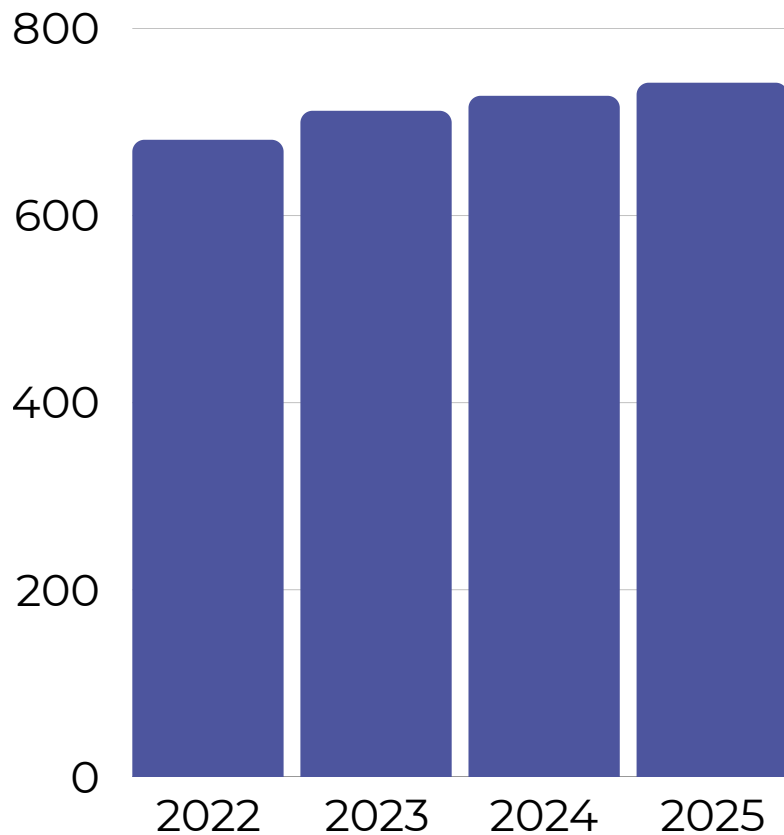
