Fund a 24/7 Behavioral Health Facility

- Support the \$10M funding in HB 1 and SB 1 that will purchase land and detail planning for a 115-bed inpatient psychiatric crisis center with a dedicated adolescent unit.
- Brazoria County has no inpatient psychiatric beds, forcing residents to seek care far away.

Expand School-Based Mental Health Services

- Enhance counseling services in public schools and higher education.
- Prioritize in-home visits and follow-up for at-risk youth

Increase the Pipeline of Licensed Professional Counselors (LPCs)

- Address high LPC supervision costs and limited reimbursement options.
