# LEADERSHIP PEARLAND

Leadership Pearland is a program which identifies and develops talented and committed citizens who aspire to provide leadership in Pearland's business and community activities. The program develops leaders by providing quality, relevant, leadership skills training to match the dynamic needs of the community. The Program teaches participants about Pearland's governmental, educational, economic, and cultural organizations and encourages future leaders to explore options for personal involvement and relationship building. Leadership Pearland creates opportunities for participants to form effective connections with current, past, and future leaders in the community. The program includes an empowering leadership training segment within each session, led by local professionals, and culminates at a celebratory graduation. Leadership Pearland will facilitate appointments of graduates into leadership roles within the Pearland Chamber of Commerce and other community organizations upon program completion.

### Purpose:

To enhance and motivate emerging leaders to develop their potential for civic leadership and commitment to the community of Pearland. To strengthen knowledge in community affairs and become acquainted and more involved in the Chamber of Commerce and its activities.

### **Tuition:**

The cost of the program is \$1,500 and is payable by the individual, the employer or a sponsoring organization. Tuition covers most meals, overnight accommodations, supplemental transportation and course materials. Full payment for the program must be remitted to the Pearland Leadership Foundation upon acceptance to the course.

### **Commitment:**

Leadership Pearland requires a serious time commitment from participants. If tuition is paid by an employer and the applicant leaves their employment, no refunds will be given. Tuition remains vested in the original applicant. Attendance for the community leader's reception, retreat, and overnight stay in Austin are mandatory.

### Attendance:

The Leadership Pearland program consists of mandatory attendance to the initial reception, a two-day retreat, overnight trip to our state capital and six day-long sessions, once each month, beginning in September and ending in June. Participants are expected to attend all sessions and are welcome to attend monthly Chamber and Community Events. Participants will be removed from the program if more than 12 cumulative program hours are missed.

### Eligible Candidates:

Prime candidates for Leadership Pearland are those individuals who are emerging as leaders within their chosen careers and/or various community organizations and agencies, or current leaders wishing to improve their knowledge and leadership skills. They will represent every sector of the community and will be individuals with enthusiasm and dedication.

### Membership:

The Leadership Pearland Class will receive a one-year complimentary membership to the Pearland Chamber of Commerce.

## ELIGIBILITY AND ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

Please read the following eligibility and attendance requirements prior to completing the Leadership Pearland application.

To be **eligible**, an applicant must:

- Live or work in Pearland
- Be 21 years or older
- Complete the application & consent forms in full before the August 11th

### deadline

- Submit the \$1,500 non-refundable payment to the Pearland Leadership Foundation prior to September start date
- Be available to attend all sessions
- Obtain employer's approval to participate in the program

### Applications are accepted on a first come, first serve basis.

### They are due no later than August 11th, 2023 at 5PM.

No candidate for office may be a participant in the class. Should a participant choose to run for office after being selected for the program that participant will be allowed to complete the program but will be asked not to discuss their candidacy.

No exclusion shall be made on the basis of race, age, sex, religious preference, or physical disability.

### PARTICIPANT ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS:

It is expected that a participant attend every session in its entirety.

### ABSENTEEISM:

Missing over twelve hours is grounds for dismissal from the class. The reception, two-day retreat, and the overnight trip to Austin are mandatory. These events are integral parts of the Leadership Pearland program. A participant absent from any one of these stated events will be removed from the program, with no refund of tuition.

### CONTRIBUTION TO YOUR COMMUNITY:

Each Leadership class is required to complete a group service project that benefits the community. The type and scope of the project is determined by the talents, resources and creativity of the class participants. The project must involve all of the class members and is designed to leave a lasting impact on the community.
