The Chamber is aware of the impact of Hurricane Beryl on our businesses earlier this month. The Chamber sent comments of support and requests to Pearland City Council related to ensuring the recovery process is easy for businesses.

Pearland City Council acted on two areas:

- Waived permit fees related to damage by the storm
- Extended the temporary sign ordinance for companies whose primary sign was damaged

Employment Situation

The June 2024 Houston Area Employment Situation that was released by Workforce Solutions – Gulf Coast shows Pearland has the lowest unemployment percentages in the region (4.1%, up from last month's 3.4%). All 18 cities in the Houston region saw unemployment increase month over month. Brazoria County's unemployment is 4.9%. The Houston region's unemployment is currently 4.2%, while the national average is 4.0% (page 16 of the report). The report highlights that unemployment in the region increased primarily due to the closure of all 99 Cent Stores nationwide, resulting in significant retail job losses, and weaker-than-expected performance in sectors such as Leisure and Hospitality and Professional and Business Services

Sales Tax Update

The City of Pearland receives updates on sales tax collection from the state. Sales Tax collections are a great tool to evaluate the local economy. The report is always from two months prior, so the most recent report reflects May's numbers. The total net collections increased compared to the previous May by \$336,728 and is 4.2% behind the city's adopted annual budget. The current period collections

compared to last year are up 1.5%. Page 2 of the report compares Pearland to other cities across the state.
