#### The Voice of Business

The Pearland Chamber of Commerce hosted Pearland Day in Austin last month. Pearland made a strong impact at the Capitol for Pearland Day in Austin, with nearly 100 individuals advocating for our community and connecting with key decision-makers.

#### **Employment Situation**

The February 2025 Houston Area Employment Situation report, released by Workforce Solutions – Gulf Coast, shows that Pearland continues to maintain one of the lowest unemployment rates in the region at 4.0%, a slight increase from 3.9% in January. Brazoria County's unemployment rate stands at 4.5%, while the Houston MSA reports an overall unemployment rate of 4.5%, which is above both the state (4.1%) and national (4.0%) averages. The region experienced a moderate gain in employment, adding 15,200 jobs over the month; however, several sectors posted losses, including Professional and Business Services (-1,300), Manufacturing (-900), and Trade, Transportation, and Utilities (-500), reflecting broader economic caution.

### **Sales Tax Update**

The City of Pearland receives updates on sales tax collection from the state. Sales Tax collections are a great tool to evaluate the local economy. The report is always from two months prior, so the most recent report reflects January's numbers. The total net collections increased compared to the previous January by \$77,639 and is 5.2% above the city's adopted annual budget. The current period collections compared to last year are down 2.7%. Page 2 of the report compares Pearland to other cities across the state.
