# CITY OF PEARLAND PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION

The legal Authority for the **Planning and Zoning Commission** in Texas is found in Section 211.007 of the Texas Local Government Code and Section 7.01 of the City Charter. The Planning and Zoning Commission is composed of seven (7) members appointed by the City Council. Board members serve for terms of three (3) years with no term limits. A quorum consists of a majority of the commission's members and an affirmative vote of a majority of those present is required to pass upon pending questions. The Planning and Zoning Commission is an advisory Board to the City Council on land use matters, while acting as final decision-maker on matters relating to subdivision plat approval.

The Planning and Zoning Commission fundamental powers are:

- · Recommend amendments to the master plan for the physical development of the City.
- Recommend, approve or disapprove plats of proposed subdivision submitted in accordance with city ordinance as adopted or hereafter amended.
- · Recommend to the City Council approval or disapproval of proposed changes in the zoning plan.
- Make and recommend to the City Council for adoption, plans for the clearance and rebuilding of slum districts and blighted areas which may develop within the City.
- Recommend to the City Council the amendment, extension and revision of the building code, which code shall include the minimum standards of construction for building, the minimum standards for plumbing and the minimum standards for wiring.

Submit annually to the City Manager, not less than ninety (90) days prior to the beginning of the budget year, a list of recommendations for capital improvements, which in the opinion of the commission are necessary or desirable to be constructed during the forthcoming five (5) years. Such list shall be arranged in order of preference, with recommendations as to which projects shall be constructed in which year.



### CITY OF PEARLAND PLANNING DEPARTMENT

The **City of Pearland Planning Department** is responsible for facilitating the development process in the City of Pearland.

The Planning Department knows you will have issues and questions on what you need to do as it relates to construction, land use, and appearance. The Planning Department is willing to meet with property owners, businesses, and other parties to assist you in answering questions, addressing concerns, and informing you of requirements. Some of the information we can readily assist you with are as follows:

- Zoning Allowable activities on property within the City limits.
- Platting The proper delineation of boundaries, subdivision of property, future plans, etc.
- · Subdividing The proper separation of property for sale or other reasons.
- Land Use In addition to zoning, the requirements for setbacks, parking, building lines, landscaping, façade allowances, screening, fencing, etc.
- · Variances or Special Exceptions The need for varying or obtaining a waiver from a City requirement dealing with land use issues.



or develop in the City). We suggest you contact the Planning Department to arrange a Pre-Development meeting as soon as you start thinking of expanding or developing – hopefully, a year prior to when you want to have your expansion or development to open.

The Planning Department hosts meetings to the development community, realtors, and anyone interested in planning issues.

The Planning Department is responsible for developing and maintaining short and long range plans for the growth of the City, in order to create and maintain a desirable land use pattern for an enhanced quality of life for our citizens. We want to work with you to ensure that is met.

### **CITY OF PEARLAND FIRE MARSHAL** & FIRE DEPARTMENTS



The **Pearland Fire Department** is responsible for fire suppression, emergency medical response, rescue, fire investigation, and inspections within its jurisdiction. The goal of the department is to provide for the safety and health of citizens within the City of Pearland and its Extra Territorial Jurisdiction (ETJ). The department provides 24-hour service to the citizens of Pearland and responds to more than 10,000 calls for service per year. The Department currently serves an area of over 75 square miles with a population of more than 130,000. Pearland is ranked as the 2nd fastest growing city in Texas and the Department is well suited to adapt to the ever-changing challenges this

speed presents. Since 2007, PFD has evolved from a volunteer department to a primarily career department, supplemented by part-time employees and volunteers, staffing five stations that are manned 24/7. This unique staffing plan brings the department a wealth of complementary capabilities and experience from its various personnel and their backgrounds.

The Fire Marshal's Office is responsible for the protection Jgtaylor@pearlandtx.gov of life and property through code enforcement, plans review, fire inspections, and fire cause determination.

#### Fire Marshal's Office:

- Inspections: Conduct and coordinate fire and life safety inspections.
- Fire Investigations: Conduct fire cause determination, conduct criminal investigations, and arrest and prosecute violators.
- Plan reviews: Reviews all plans to ensure that businesses are safe before being opened to the public.

### CITY OF PEARLAND POLICE DEPARTMENTS



The **Pearland Police Department** was founded on April 6, 1960 when the governing body of the City of Pearland voted to establish a full-time police department. At the time of its founding, Pearland encompassed just 2 square miles and had a population of 1,497. Three police officers, including Pearland PD's first chief of police, kept citizens safe. Fast forward to today: the City of Pearland is a dynamic growing city of 119,700 served by 168 sworn police officers.

The department is led by Chief Johnny Spires, a law enforcement executive with more than 27 years of leadership experience. Chief Spires is responsible for the department's \$25.5 million budget, 17 divisions and more than 200 City employees in various areas of the police department that include: Patrol, Traffic Enforcement, Criminal Investigations, K-9, School Resource Officers, Internal Affairs, Telecommunications, and more.

### **BRAZORIA DRAINAGE DISTRICT #4**

Brazoria Drainage District No. 4 was created by Brazoria County Commissioners Court on June 28, 1910 and on May 22, 1929, was made a Conservation and Reclamation District by Special Bill No. 25 of the Texas State Legislature. The District is governed by a 3 member elected Board of Commissioners.



Principal subdivisions located in the district include: Country Place, Silver Lake, Southwyck, Crystal Lake, West Oaks, Springfield, Sunset Meadows, Sunset Lakes, Meadow View, Pine Hollow, West Wood, Dixie Woods, and Oak Brook Estates.
